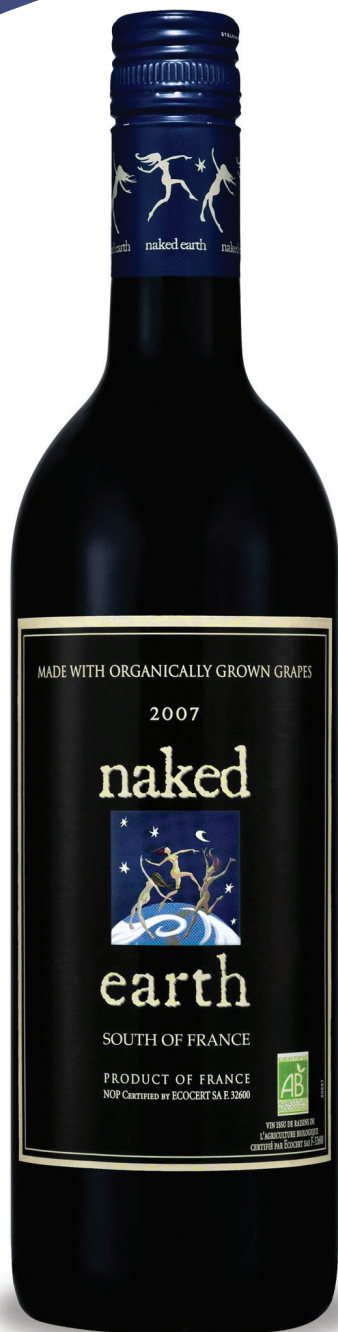

Eye

Beautiful concentration, with rich hues of dark crimson, raspberry-red at the edges

Nose

An impressive nose of strawberry and vanilla, with accents of cinnamon and smoke

Palate

A complete package: thick, rich and concentrated upon entrance, moving into notes of ripe fruits (strawberry and blueberry), the finish is long and elegantly spicy, ending with hints of dark cherries, espresso and chocolate
